

Guide for DJs and live performers

Welcome to St Mary's Church Whitkirk Community Centre! This is a short guide for DJs and live performers to help you make the most of our space.

Important rules

Music: The performance of music (both live and recorded) must stop no later than **11:30 pm**. This is a condition of our license, and is non-negotiable.

Smoke, haze and pyrotechnics: You must **not** use of atmospheric effects such as smoke or haze, or use any form of pyrotechnic device.

Lasers: You must **not** use any laser equipment.

Power

13A sockets for your equipment are available on both sides of the stage. A 16A three-phase socket is available in the stage left wing. We do not provide mains extensions or distribution.

It is your responsibility to make sure equipment is suitably tested if necessary.

Overhead equipment

You must not fly or rig any overhead equipment, either on stage or over the dancefloor, without first consulting with our technical team.
